ORDER

As per the paper read as (1) above, the Board of Studies in Sociology PG recommended to include the criterion of content similarity while considering Recognition/Equivalency of Regular UG/PG programmes and also suggested to take immediate action to include the clause in the eligibility criteria.

As per the paper read as (2) above, the Dean, Faculty of Humanities remarked that in the absence of clear cut instructions in the Regulations regarding the percentage of content similarity of regular programmes of Central or other Universities, the Board was unable to take decisions.

Vide paper read as (3) above, the Academic Council resolved to stipulate 60% of content similarity in the eligibility criteria while considering equivalency to regular UG/PG programmes (which do not satisfy the conditions specified in the clause 4.1.1 and 4.1.2 of the Regulations on Recognition and Equivalency of programmes of study). The House also resolved that the Board of Studies concerned should take decisions regarding the issuance of eligibility certificate for the purpose of higher studies, without insisting on a particular minimum percentage of content similarity.

Sanction has been accorded by the Vice Chancellor to implement the above resolution of the Academic council.

Orders are issued accordingly.
