As per paper read as (1) above, the meeting of the Board of Studies in Management Studies (PG), after considering the applications for equivalency to MBA Finance Management (distance mode) of Bharathiar University submitted by Mr. Ledin Bin Abdul Kahader and Ms Shanti, recommended not to grant equivalency to the programme with MBA (regular) programme of the University of Calicut.

Vide paper read as (2) above, the Board of Studies in Management Studies (PG) considered the application for equivalency to MBA Information Technology (distance mode) of Sikkim Manipal University submitted by Sharfras Nava M A and recommended not to grant equivalency to the programme with MBA (regular) programme of the University of Calicut.

Vide paper read as (3) above, the meeting of the Board of studies in Management Studies PG after considering similar applications also resolved that **the programmes under distance mode cannot be treated as equivalent to a programme conducted in regular mode because the criteria for equivalence such as mode of selection and admission, syllabus, time spent for direct teaching, pedagogy and evaluation are all different for these two modes.** The meeting also recommended to decline such requests by the administration in future.

Vide paper read as (4) above, the above recommendations of the Board of studies in Management Studies PG were approved by the Dean, Faculty of Commerce and Management Studies.

Vide paper read as (5) above, the Academic Council approved the recommendation of the Board of Studies as endorsed by the Dean, Faculty of Commerce and Management Studies not to grant equivalency to MBA Finance Management (distance mode) of Bharathiar University and MBA Information Technology (distance mode) of Sikkim Manipal University with MBA regular programme of the University of Calicut and and to decline such requests for equivalency to distance

programmes with regular programmes in future by the administration.

The Vice Chancellor has accorded sanction to implement the above resolution of the Academic Council.
