## **REVISED RULES GOVERNING THE “ PROF. M.M GHANI AWARD FOR THE BEST COLLEGE TEACHERS”**

1. The award is instituted in the name of Prof.M M Ghani, the first Vice Chancellor of the University of Calicut and will be known as “Prof.M.M Ghani Award for the Best College Teachers” and is given away to teachers every year since 1994-95.
2. The award comprises cash prize of Rs.25,000/-, a memento and a citation.
3. It shall be given to not more than four best teachers each in Science, Languages, Humanities and Commerce& Management Studies, selected every academic year from among the teaching staff of the Government/ Aided Colleges affiliated to the University.
4. Any teacher from the Govt/Aided college having a teaching service of 10 years can directly apply online within the time frame prescribed, through the link provided in the College Portal, preferably those having sound academic as well as social contributions.
5. A teacher can also be nominated by the Principal of the college/ the College Council/the students and the fellow teachers of the Department concerned. In such cases, consent of the nominee should be obtained.
6. The applicant should also attach a small write up not more than 250words mentioning details of class room activities by teacher/applicant to impart knowledge and to motivate students, with proof, if any. In addition, social activities outside the campus can also be mentioned.
7. Preliminary screening of applications will be only through online. Nominations received after the prescribed date shall not be considered.
8. The nominations received shall be scrutinised by a Screening Committee.
9. Nominations cleared by the Screening Committee shall be placed before an Expert Committee for an interaction and final selection.
10. A teacher who received the award once, shall not be considered.
11. The award shall be presented at a public function organised by the University, on National Teachers' Day, 5th September every year or a day fixed by the University.

12. The award is given to one teacher in each of the following Broad Areas:

(a). Science

(b). Language

(c). Humanities (including Education/ Journalism/ Physical Education etc)

(d). Commerce & Management Studies.

13. In all matters related to the awards, the decision of the Screening and Expert Committee shall be final at their respective levels.

14. It shall be the discretion of the University to decide not to give the award in any particular year/ category.
