It is notified for the information of all concerned that consequent to the publication of the results of the Fourth Semester M.A./M.Sc./M.S.W./M.T.T.M./M.Com.Regular/Supplementary/Improvement Examinations, April 2026 (PG-CBCSS-2019 Scheme, 2022 Admission onwards) and the M.Sc.
