Terms and Conditions

- 1) The bidder should have a valid GST registration and a copy of the GST registration certificate should be submitted along with the quotation.
- 2) The genuine & new spares/components should be provided.
- 3) The bidder should have local presence with service centre in Kerala.
- 4) The bidder should have ISO certification and a copy of the ISO certificate should be submitted along with the quotation.
- 5) The rate quoted should be inclusive of all taxes and all other charges, including transportation, loading and unloading etc.
- 6) The Successful bidder shall complete the work within one week of receiving the supply/work order.
- 7) Minimum of 6 months on-site warranty should be provided for the display panel.

Other Conditions

- 1) The University of Calicut, if it feels so, can re-negotiate the price with the lowest evaluated eligible quotationer.
- 2) The final acceptance of the quotations rests entirely with the University of Calicut who do not bind themselves to accept the lowest or any quotation. But the quotationers on their part should be prepared to carry out such portion of the supplies included in their quotations as may be allotted to them.
- 3) All rules and regulations of the tender/quotation shall be in accordance with the Stores Purchase Manual of the Government of Kerala.
- 4) Vendor/Contractor shall ensure all necessary support for attending faults and carrying out such activities at site.

General Conditions

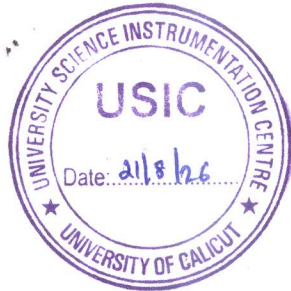
- 1) Withdrawal from the quotation after it is accepted or failure to supply within a specified time or according to specifications will entail cancellation of the order and purchases being made at the offerer's expenses from elsewhere, any loss incurred thereby being payable by the defaulting party. In such an event the University reserves also the right to remove the defaulter's name from the list of University suppliers permanently or for a specified number of years.
- 2) No representation for enhancement of price once accepted will be considered during the currency of the contract.
- 3) Any attempt on the part of quotationers or their agents to influence the Officers concerned in their favour by personal canvassing will disqualify the quotationers.
- 4) If any license or permit is required, quotationers must specify in their quotation and also state the authority to whom application is to be made.
- 5) The quotation may be for the entire or part supplies. But the quotations should be prepared to carry out such portion of the supplies included in their quotation as may be allotted to them.
- 6) In cases where a successful quotationer, after having made partial supplies fails to fulfill the contracts in full, all or any of the materials not supplied may, at the discretion of the Purchasing Officer be purchased by means of another tender/quotation or by negotiation or from the next higher quotationer who had offered to supply already and the loss, if any, caused to the University shall thereby together with such sums as may be fixed by the University towards damages be recovered from the defaulting quotationer.
- 7) The prices quoted should be inclusive of all taxes, duties, cesses, etc., which are or may become payable by the contractor under existing or future laws or rules of the country of origin /supply or delivery during the course of execution of the contract.
- 8) Ordinarily payments will be made only after the supplies are actually verified and taken to stock but in exceptional cases, payments against satisfactory shipping documents including certificates of Insurance will be made up to 90 per cent of the value of the materials at the discretion of University. Bank charges incurred in connection with payment against documents through bank will be to the account of the contractor. The firms will produce stamped pre-receipted invoices in all cases where payments (advance/final) for release of railway receipts/shipping documents are made through Banks. In exceptional cases where the stamped receipts of the firms are not received for the payments (in advance) the unstamped receipt of the Bank (i.e. counterfoils of pay-in-slips issued by the Bank) alone may be accepted as a valid proof for the payment made.
- 9) Any sum of money due and payable to the successful tenderer/quotationer or contractor from University shall be adjusted against any sum of money due to University from him under any other contracts.

10) Special conditions, if any, printed on the quotation sheets of the quotationer or attached with the quotation will not be applicable to the contract unless they are expressly accepted in writing by the purchaser.
