The University of Calicut has extended the application deadline for the Prof. M.M.Ghani Award for the Best College Teachers for the academic years 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 in affiliated Government and Aided Colleges. Applications can now be submitted online through the Centralized College Portal until **20.07.2026**.

Teachers from Govt./Aided colleges with teaching experience of 10 years or more are eligible to apply for the award. Applications have to be submitted online through the link provided in the Centralized College Portal. Applicants are required to submit two bound copies of all the supporting documents for the online application, within 10 days from the last date for submission of online application.

**REVISED RULES GOVERNING THE “PROF. M.M GHANI AWARD
FOR THE BEST COLLEGE TEACHERS” (2023-24 & 2024-25)**

1. The award is instituted in the name of Prof.M M Ghani, the first Vice Chancellor of the University of Calicut and will be known as “Prof.M.M Ghani Award for the Best College Teachers” and is given away to teachers every year since 1994-95.
2. The award comprises cash prize of Rs.25,000/-, a memento and a citation.
3. It shall be given to not more than four best teachers each one in the following broad areas :
 - (a) Science
 - (b) Language
 - (c) Humanities (including Education/ Journalism/ Physical Education etc)
 - (d)Commerce & Management Studies.They shall be selected every academic year from among the teaching staff of the Government/ Aided Colleges affiliated to the University.
4. Any teacher from the Govt/Aided college having a teaching experience of 10 years or above can directly apply online within the time frame prescribed, through the link provided in the College Portal, preferably those having sound academic as well as social contributions.
5. A teacher can also be nominated by the Principal of the college / the College Council / fellow teachers of the Department concerned / Students through a faculty / Principal. In such cases, consent of the nominee should be obtained.
6. Preliminary screening of applications will be only through online. Nominations received after the prescribed date shall not be considered.
7. The nominations received shall be scrutinized by a Screening Committee.
8. Nominations cleared by the Screening Committee shall be placed before an Expert Committee for an interaction and final selection.
9. A teacher who received the award once, shall not be considered again.
10. The award shall be presented at a public function organized by the University, on National Teachers' Day, 5th September every year or a day fixed by the University.
11. In all matters related to the awards, the decision of the Screening and Expert Committee shall be final at their respective levels.
12. It shall be the discretion of the University to decide not to give the award in any particular year/ category.
