The auction will be conducted in accordance with the relevant provisions applicable for disposal of surplus stores/property under the Store Purchase Manual, Kerala Financial Code, and University rules/orders.

Interested persons may inspect the dogs at the Department of Forensic Science, University of Calicut, Kerala Police Academy, Thrissur, on 19-08-2026 from 10.00 AM to 04.00 PM, with prior permission of the Department.

Terms and Conditions

1. The auction will be conducted by the authorized officer in the presence of the Head of the Department/authorized Gazetted Officer, and the final bids will be recorded in the Auction Register.

2. The auction will be conducted on an “as is where is” basis. The Department/University does not provide any guarantee regarding the future health, performance, trainability, temperament or suitability of the dogs for any specific purpose.
3. The auction will start from the base amount fixed for each dog. Bids below the base amount will not be accepted.
4. Intending bidders shall remit the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) shown against each dog before the commencement of the auction.
5. The EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned after the auction. The EMD of the successful bidder will be adjusted towards the final bid amount.
6. The highest bid shall be subject to confirmation by the competent authority. Mere submission of the highest bid shall not confer any right on the bidder to claim the dog.
7. If the highest bid is found to be unreasonably low, or if the competent authority considers that the auction is not advantageous to the University, the auction may be cancelled and re-auction may be conducted with wider publicity.
8. The successful bidder shall remit the full bid amount, after adjusting the EMD, immediately after confirmation of the auction or within the time fixed by the Department/University.
9. The dog shall be released to the successful bidder only after remittance of the full amount, completion of all required formalities, and signing of the required undertaking.
10. The successful bidder shall take delivery of the dog within the time stipulated by the Department. If the successful bidder fails to take delivery within the stipulated time, the Department/University may levy reasonable retention charges and/or arrange re-auction. In the event of re-auction due to default by the successful bidder, the amount already remitted by the defaulting bidder shall be liable to forfeiture.
11. The successful bidder shall produce valid identity proof and address proof at the time of completing the auction formalities.
12. The successful bidder shall submit a written undertaking to provide proper care, feeding, shelter, vaccination, medical care, exercise, and humane treatment to the dog.
13. The dog shall not be abandoned, subjected to cruelty, used for any illegal purpose, or transferred for any activity contrary to animal-welfare laws and other applicable rules.
14. The Department/University reserves the right to reject any bid, postpone the auction, cancel the auction, or withdraw any dog from the auction without assigning any reason.
